SH AND HS TREATMENTS:

Spray/Hill (SH) and Hill/Spray (HS) refer to the time of application in relation to hilling, i.e., SH means the plot was sprayed immediately prior to hilling; HS means the plot was hilled prior to spraying.

WEED RATINGS:

Weed ratings were made on the weed species most prevalent. The rating scale is as follows (unless noted on plots): 0 = No Control; 100 = Complete Control

CROP INJURY RATINGS:

Crop injury ratings reflect stand reduction and the reduction of plant vigor due to herbicide effects.

VINE DESICCATION RATINGS:

Vine desiccation ratings reflect per cent of leaves or stems desiccated.

The rating scale is as follows: 0 = No Injury; 100 = Complete Kill
